## 1 MOCA SOCIAL POINT SCORE (NSW)

### 1.1 Purpose

- To encourage Members to attend all types of advertised events, particularly with their Morgans.

### 1.2 Period

- The calculation of points is from 1 September to 31 August.

### 1.3 Award

- Members with the first, second and third highest points received are recognised. There is a perpetual trophy recognising the winner and individual recognition for first, second and third place rankings.
- If partners receive the same number of points then the award will be jointly awarded.

### 1.4 Subject for points

- The subjects for points are:
  - **Runs:** weekend or holiday runs organised by MOCA and listed in the MOCA calendar.
  - **Non-driving gathering:** MOCA events (such as General Meetings and Annual General Meetings) listed in the MOCA calendar where driving a Morgan isn't expected.

### 1.5 Points allocation

Subject for Points	Points Allotted
Attending a run in a Morgan as either driver or passenger.	125
Attending a non-driving gathering (eg AGMs or General Meetings) or attending a run in another type of car as driver or passenger.	75
Bringing a guest (not your partner) or bringing a potential next generation Morgan owner (10 points per person)	30 max

### 1.6 Qualification

- Club Captain(s) and Club President are not eligible.
- Member must be a financial member at the time of the Award.

## 2 MOCA MID-WEEK SOCIAL POINT SCORE (NSW)

### 2.1 Purpose

- To encourage Members to attend mid-week social events, particularly with their Morgans.

### 2.2 Period

- The calculation of points is from 1 September to 31 August.

### 2.3 Award

- Members with the first, second and third highest points received are recognised. There is a perpetual trophy recognising the winner and individual recognition for first, second and third place rankings.
- If partners receive the same number of points then the award will be jointly awarded.

### 2.4 Subject for points

- The subjects for points are the mid-week social runs organised by MOCA and listed in the MOCA calendar.

### 2.5 Points allocation

Subject for Points	Points Allotted
Attending in a Morgan as either driver or passenger.	125
Attending in another type of car either as driver or passenger.	75
Bringing a guest (not your partner) or bringing a potential next generation Morgan owner (10 points per person)	30 max

### 2.6 Qualification

- Club Captain(s) and Club President are not eligible.
- Member must be a financial member at the time of the Award.

## 3 JOHN MOTT TROPHY (WA)

- Awarded to a WA member of MOCA who has made a significant contribution during the year.

## 4 LONG DISTANCE AWARD (NATIONAL)

### 4.1 Purpose

- The purpose of this award is to:

- encourage members to drive their Morgan,
- facilitate camaraderie with fellow enthusiasts
- encourage members to keep their older Morgan running
- show the history of Morgans and provide enjoyment of the general public.
- It also demonstrates the reliability of individual cars in achieving the distance travelled, and by displaying the plaques on the dashboard or in the engine bay, adds to their provenance.

#### **4.2 Period**

- The calculation of distance is from 1 September to 31 August.

#### **4.3 Award**

- The award takes the form of a small plaque with participant's name, particulars of the vehicle/s, the relevant year involved and the distance/s travelled.

#### **4.4 Rules**

- The distance travelled must be more than 5,000 km or 3,100 miles during the MOCA year from 1st September to 31st August.
- Vehicles participating must not be 'daily drivers'.
- Owners of more than one Morgan can combine the distance travelled in each Morgan to reach the requisite distance.
- Members should accurately record the odometer readings of their car/s on or after September 1 of each year to ensure they have an accurate reading on or before August 31 of the following year. MOCA will be relying on member's honesty and integrity in the provision of accurate and truthful information.
- Any and all defective odometers are the responsibility of the car's owner/driver to repair. Estimates of distance travelled will be accepted, however the basis of the estimate should be provided with the application form.
- The Club Captains and / or Club President reserve the right to challenge odometer readings and inspect odometers.
- Dash plaques will contain the driver's name, Morgan model & year, contest year, and distance driven.
- Dash plaques will be presented as soon as possible after the conclusion of the grace period (1st– 30th September). Requests for plaques after the grace period will not be accepted.
- Completed forms must be sent to Club Captain NSW. Verbal information will not be accepted.

#### **4.5 Qualification**

- The Award is open to all members MOCA.

### **5 NATIONAL AWARDS**

#### **5.1 Description of National Awards**

- Peter Morgan Trophy:  
This trophy is awarded to the member performing exceptional service to MOCA.

- The Hardys Hero Trophy:  
This trophy is awarded to the member performing a good deed in the interests of MOCA.
- The Dennis Minogue Big Valve Trophy:  
This trophy is awarded to the MOCA member who sustains the greatest set-back to his/her Club life within the Club year.
- The Mickey Mouse Trophy:  
This trophy is awarded to the member performing an unusual deed during the year.
- The Leadfoot Trophy:  
This trophy is awarded to the Morgan driver who uses his right foot to gain the most advantage on a MOCA run during the year, with or without a stern discussion with the local constabulary.
- Carolyn Scott Trophy:  
In memory of Carolyn Scott and awarded to a novice competition driver. The award is intended to encourage new members into the Club to participate in competition events.

## **5.2 Nominations**

- Members can nominate other members for these awards by written submission to the President.
- Nominations must be made before the closing date of 15 September each year.
- The President will appoint an advisory group of committee members each year to assist in determining winners.
- The President will have a second or casting vote.
